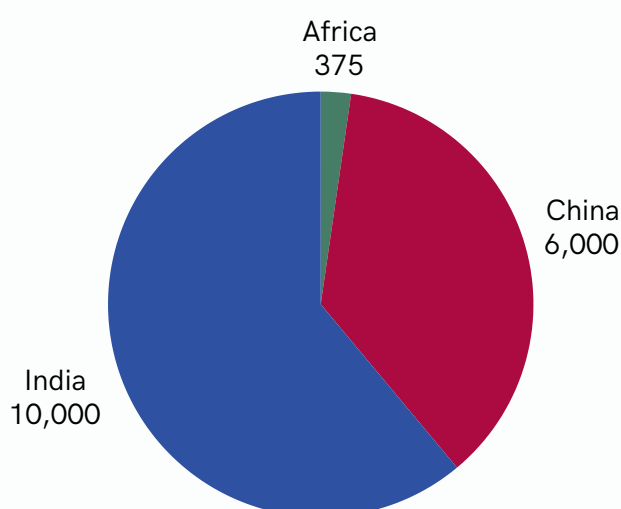
Overall Market Growth



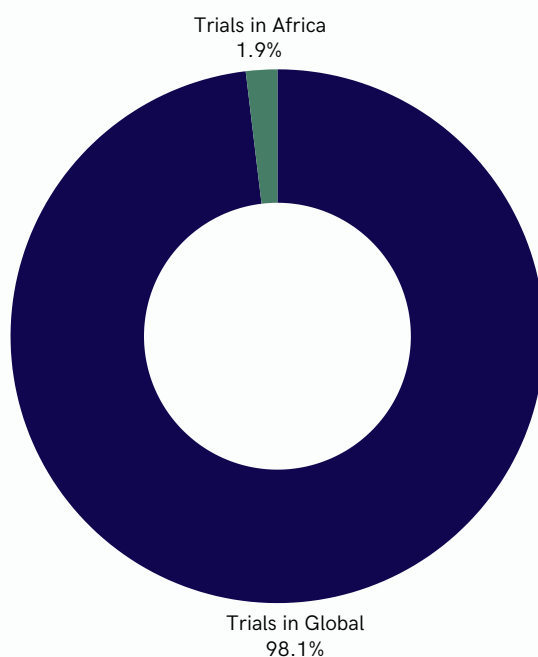

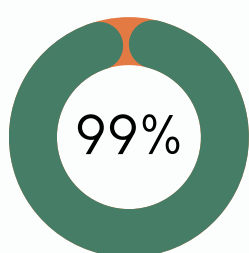

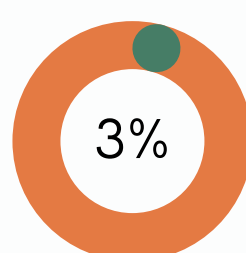
